SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 10, 2010  
6:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Crout. The Invocation was given by Councilman Middleton who asked for a moment of silence in honor of Doris Cole who passed away March 9. Mayor Crout led the Pledge of Allegiance. All members of council except Councilman Cole were present.

There were no public comments or special requests.

IRRIGATION SYSTEM FOR THE MUNICIPAL CENTER      Bids for the irrigation system for the Municipal Center from ALL ABOUT LANDSCAPING, HUMP'S LANDSCAPE, HERNANDEZ LANDSCAPING, and DALTON TURF & IRRIGATION were discussed. Councilman Looper made a motion seconded by Councilman Middleton to accept the bid from DALTON TURF & IRRIGATION for \$5475.00. The funds would come from the building maintenance account. All voted in favor.

REPLACE POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE      Chief Inman presented a quote from Bobby Jones Ford for a fully equipped 2010 Crown Victoria Model P7B Interceptor for \$34,587.56. Councilman Middleton made a motion seconded by Councilman Looper to discuss. Mayor Crout said that the plan had been to budget two cars in next year's budget but suggested instead to purchase one car now out of the capital replacement account and budget one more car next year. Councilman Middleton and Councilman Looper withdrew their motion and second to discuss and instead moved and seconded to buy the vehicle. All voted in favor.

FIRST READING OF A BAN ORDINANCE FOR A WATER/SEWER REVENUE BOND      A Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$2,743,000 for a construction loan which will be paid back by the RUS loan/grant. This interim financing will be at 2.63% for 12 months. The Town does not receive the money directly but it is placed in an account where the RUS will disperse funds as needed. The Town will only pay interest on the amount of each draw on the account. Councilman Middleton made a motion seconded by Councilman Looper to approve first reading of the ordinance to get the loan from BB&T Bank. The motion

carried with Councilman Middleton, Councilman Looper, and Mayor Crout voting in favor and Councilman Harvell opposed.

#### EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilman Looper made a motion seconded by Councilman Middleton to go into executive session to discuss contractual matters. All voted in favor. Councilman Middleton made a motion seconded by Councilman Harvell to return to general session. All voted in favor. Information was received but no action was taken in the executive session.

Councilman Harvell made a motion seconded by Councilman Middleton to adjourn. All voted in favor. Adjournment was at 6:40 pm.
