

TOWN OF WILLIAMSTON
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

MAY 23, 2012

2:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Crout. The Invocation was given by the Mayor and the Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmen were present except Councilman Loper who did arrive after the vote to go into executive session.

There were no public comments.

Mayor Crout announced that the meeting was called at the request of the Town's Attorney Richard Thompson to hear legal advice. The Mayor asked Mr. Thompson if the council needed to go into executive session and Mr. Thompson responded that either the Council or the public (only The Journal reporter and non-essential Town staff) could leave the council chambers. At the promise from the Mayor that no votes would be taken, the reporter chose to leave as well as Town staff.

Councilman Harvell made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to go into executive session to hear legal advice from Mr. Thompson concerning Pacolet-Milliken property contractual matters. The motion carried with Councilman Durham opposed.

Councilman Hagood made a motion seconded by Councilman Durham to return to public session. All voted in favor. Mayor Crout said no action was taken.

Councilman Harvell made a motion seconded by Councilman Loper to adjourn and there was no opposition. The Mayor announced the meeting adjourned. Adjournment was at 2:58 p.m.
