

TOWN OF WILLIAMSTON  
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
APRIL 11, 2013  
6:00 PM

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Durham. The mayor gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmen were present including newly elected Ward 2 Councilman Rocky Burgess who was sworn in on April 3, the day after winning the election.

Due to time constraints, there were no public comments.

Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to approve the agenda as presented for the order of business for the meeting. The motion carried with Councilman Harvell opposed.

MOVE DISPATCH TO ANDERSON COUNTY Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Scott to approve moving our dispatch services to Anderson County. All voted in favor.

VOTE ON CLEAR WATER CONTRACT PROPOSAL Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Scott to accept the Clear Water contract proposal for waste water treatment plant operation. The new contract would save approximately \$91,000 to \$107,000 per year and take effect May 1. All voted in favor.

VOTE ON ADMINISTRATOR POSITION Councilman Scott made a motion seconded by Councilman Burgess to eliminate the position of Town Administrator. All councilmen individually commented that the decision was not due to any wrong doing but based on the town no longer needing the position. All voted in favor.

PARKFEST EVENT FUNDING Jack Ellenburg gave a presentation about plans for the Park Fest event and requested \$3,000 funding. Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to approve the funding from the Hospitality Tax. Councilman Harvell asked if it wasn't necessary to amend the budget. At the advice of Mr. Thompson, Council voted first to approve the funding with Councilman Harvell opposed. Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Burgess to amend the Hospitality budget. The motion carried with Councilman Harvell opposed.

GWBA EVENT FUNDING Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Burgess to approve \$800 in funding for the GWBA "Party in the Park" event. The motion carried with Councilman Harvell opposed. Mayor Durham then made a motion seconded by Councilman Hagood to amend the Hospitality budget. The motion carried with Councilman Harvell opposed.

Mayor Durham made a motion seconded by Councilman Scott to adjourn. All voted in favor. Adjournment was at 6:26 p.m.
