Regular Meeting

August 3, 2015 Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

Mayor Durham called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. All council members were present.

2. Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance

3. Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Councilman Hagood to accept the July 6th minutes as presented.

4. Public Comments

Pam Owens asked for the Council to consider allowing yard sale signs to be permitted for one day for advertising. Randy Woodson spoke about his feelings toward certain members of Council. David Meade spoke on behalf of the Spring Water Festival about the event.

5. Gray Drive Bridge

Pam Owens addressed the Council about supporting the opening of the Gray Drive bridge.

6. Funding repairs on Park Street

7. NPDES permit oversight on the waste water treatment plant
