November 5, 2018

### Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

Mayor Durham called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. All members of Council were present, except for Councilman Harvell.

2. Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance

3. Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Councilman Hagood to accept the October 1, 2018 minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Burgess. Everyone voted in favor.

Sherri Cole gave information on the Christmas parade. Josh Shore, with Medshore, gave an update to Council on their operation status.

5. Presentations

Kevin Marsee gave an update on the police department. Sonya Crandall gave a update on Envision Williamston. Community Liaison, Debbie Chapman, gave a report to Council on Code Enforcement for the month.

6. Second Reading on an Ordinance to Participate in the Set Off Debt Program

A motion was made by Mayor Durham to pass the ordinance on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hagood. All voted in favor.

7. Amendment to Medshore Lease Agreement

A motion was made by Councilman Burgess to pass the Ordinance on 1<sup>st</sup> reading. The motion was seconded by Councilman Alexander for discussion. Everyone voted in favor. The amendment was to leave their lease at \$1000 a month, instead of it increasing to \$1200.
