Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

Mayor Durham called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. All members of Council were present.

2. Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Durham led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Approval of Minutes

5. Presentations

Jody Culbertson, with the police department, gave a presentation to Council on a sample Wellness Program he would like to implement for the Town. Mayor Durham gave the Council a presentation on each department's goals and assessments. Richard Greer presented Council with his plans to turn the old water plant into a Brewery and Restaurant.
