Special Called Meeting – Work Session
04/19/21

I. Call to Order, Invocation, Pledge

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor at 1:30 p.m.

Mayor Burgess, Council lady Austin, Councilman Hagood, Councilman Cole, and Councilman Alexander were present.

Councilman Hagood led the invocation, and the Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Second Reading on an Ordinance Prohibiting Trespassing on Town Property

Councilman Alexander read the Ordinance aloud.

Councilman Hagood moved to approve the Ordinance.

III. Second Reading on an Ordinance Prohibiting Disruption of Public Meetings

IV. Second Reading on an Ordinance Repealing Rental Housing Regulations

V. Second Reading on an Ordinance Allocating Funds for Road Erosion

The ordinance was read by Councilman Alexander.

VI. Amend Agenda to Add a Resolution for Park Rules

Mayor Burgess made a motion to amend the agenda to add a resolution for park rules to include “no parking on the grass.” The motion was seconded by Councilman Alexander. Everyone voted in favor.

Mayor Burgess made a motion to pass the resolution. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hagood.

Councilman Cole then made a motion to amend the resolution to include “No parking on the grass, with the exception of at the Mayor’s or the Mayor’s Designee’s discretion.” The motion was seconded by Councilman Alexander. The motion was approved unanimously.

VII. Approval to Award Bid to Talbot Tennis for Pickleball Courts

Mayor Burgess made a motion to accept the bid from Talbot Tennis. The motion was seconded by Council Lady Austin. The motion was approved unanimously.

VIII. Amend Agenda to Amend the Hospitality Budget

reading on the ordinance amending the Hospitality Budget to appropriate \$80,000 out of this year's budget for the Pickle Ball Courts. The remaining amount will be budgeted out of next year's budget. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hagood. The motion was approved unanimously.

IX. Appointment of a Zoning and Appeals Board Member

Council Lady Austin made a motion to appoint Barry Thompson to the Zoning and Appeals Board. The motion as seconded by Councilman Alexander. The motion passed unanimously.
