The deadline for applications is Monday, November 13, 2023. You may drop the form off at Town Hall, mail to

Trees may be assembled between Saturday, November 4, and Friday November 24, between 9am and 9pm daily and on
Sat. November 25th until 3:00 pm. The Town Hall will be closed for Thanksgiving on Thursday November 23.
Doors will reopen for decorating on Friday and Saturday to finalize the trees before the official lighting on Sunday
evening, Nov. 26th. All Trees must be up and ready to view by 3:00 pm, Saturday, November 25th.
Please do not commit to placing a tree if you can't follow through with doing it, as our spaces are limited. A lot of
planning goes into this event. Respecting deadlines and commitments is important!
Drop box voting will run through Dec. 26th. A drop box will be placed in the Town Hall for visitors to vote for their
favorite tree. Please do not touch the trees, ornaments or decorations of others. If your tree is too large to install in the
spot you are assigned, please ask for assistance. Extension cords will be installed by the town prior to the
opening day of the lighting. Please bring your own cord to use while decorating the tree. If your tree is tall, please
bring your own ladder or step stool.
Do not place anything on the walls. A plaque will be placed on the wall for you by town staff.
Deck the Halls will share opening night with Winter Wonderland and the Christmas Park starting at 6:00 pm on
Sunday, November 26th. Hours for viewing the trees will be Monday-Friday from 9:00am –9:00pm and on
Saturday and Sundays from 10:00 am to 10:00 pm. Deadline to remove trees will be before Saturday, January 13th
