

## **Notice of Public Hearing Concerning Program Performance and Accomplishments**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on March 31, 2026, at 11:30 AM at 12 West Main Street, Williamston, SC 29697 the Town of Williamston will hold a public hearing concerning program performance and accomplishments conducted under a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project known as 4-CI-22-014, Mill Village Water Upgrade wherein the following activities:

Mobilization, clearing and grubbing, erosion control, traffic control, grassing, cut and replace asphalt and concrete driveways. The completed project contains 6,695 LF of new 6 inch water line and 3,175 LF of new 2 inch water line, 7 new hydrant assemblies, and 6 new blow-off assemblies installed in the southern portion of the Mill Village Neighborhood that includes Williams St. Extension, East 1<sup>st</sup> Street, East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, East 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, East 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Gossett Drive, West 1<sup>st</sup> Street, West 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, West 4<sup>th</sup> Street, West 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and Circle Drive. With the Addition of 300-LF of new 6-inch water line and one new hydrant assembly installed along Gossett Drive.

Total CDBG funds – \$880,000, Total match funds \$822,855, Total project cost 1,702,855 Total beneficiaries 232 of which 174 are LMI.

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of the Town of Williamston's Citizen Participation Plan, developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, providing for the participation of the citizens of the Town of Williamston in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds.
